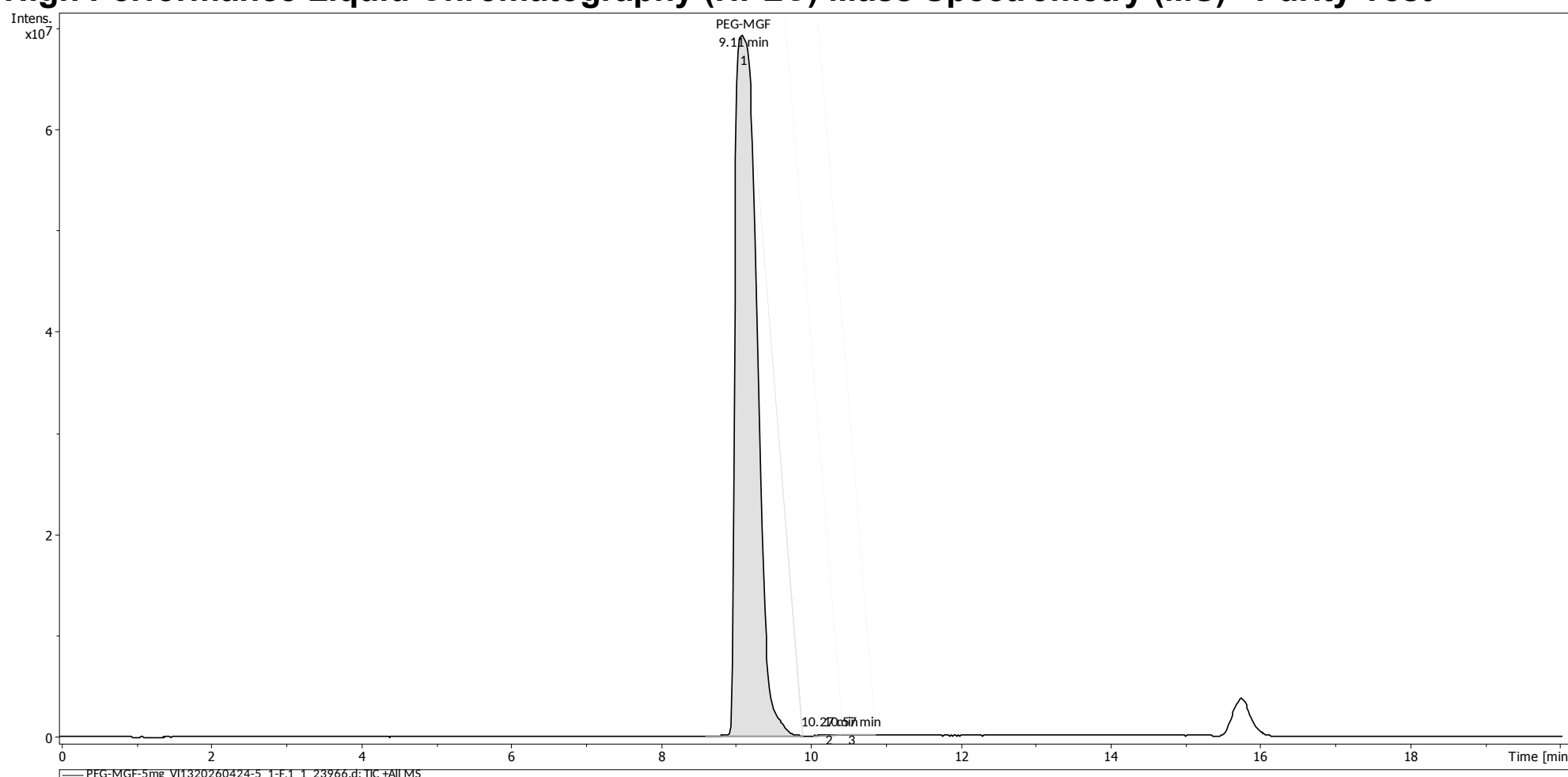

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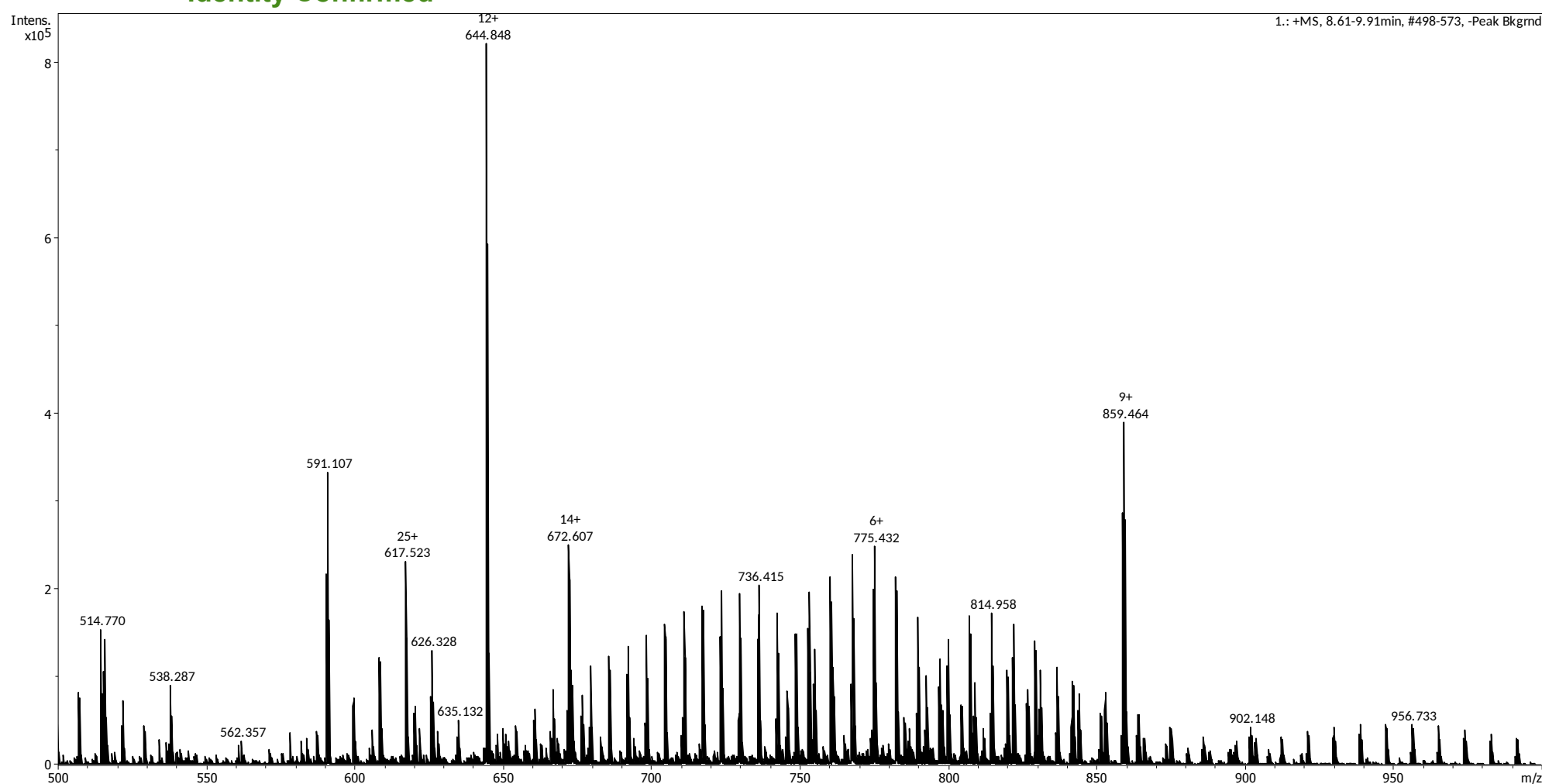
Mass Spectrometry (MS) – Identity Test

Molecules with PEG added are difficult to interpret. In order to confirm MGF is the base peptide, mass spectrometer provides a slight fragmentation energy to the sample, causing some MGF to detach from the PEG chain and partially fragment further.

Several peaks specific to MGF indicate it's identity – 645, 717, 844, 918, 956, and 1434.

Not all of the peaks are always visible and only 2-3 of them can confirm the identity.
